TEAM WORK & SYNERGY

- 1. The idea of synergy in teamwork refers to the concept that when individuals work together as a team, they can achieve more than the sum of their individual efforts.
- 2. Synergy occurs when team members collaborate in a way that allows them to capitalize on each other's strengths and expertise.
- 3. Synergy can also arise from the shared motivation and commitment that comes from working in a team. When team members share a common goal and sense of purpose, they can inspire and support each other to achieve their objectives.
- 4. Synergy is often achieved through effective teamwork processes such as communication, collaboration, and conflict resolution.
- 5. When synergy is present in a team, it can lead to greater productivity, creativity, and innovation, as well as improved job satisfaction and team cohesion. 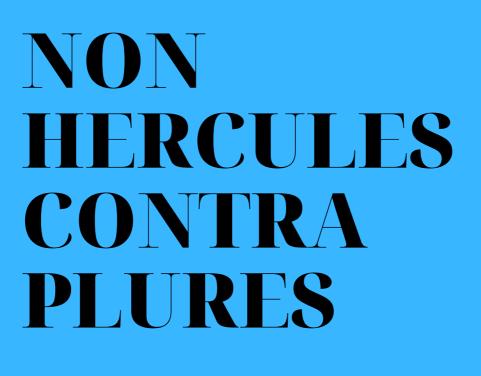
DURATION:

One day - 8 hours



Action plan:

- 1. Icebreaker: The facilitator will start the workshop by having participants introduce themselves and share one thing they hope to gain from the workshop.
- 2. Communication Styles Activity: Participants take a quiz or participate in an activity to identify their communication styles. The facilitator will lead a discussion on how different communication styles can impact group communication.
- 3. Role-playing Exercise: Participants are split into pairs and given a scenario where they need to practice effective communication skills. For example, one person can play the role of a supervisor giving feedback to an employee, and the other person can play the role of the employee.
- 4. Group Brainstorming Activity: Participants will be given a task or problem to solve as a group. They will need to use effective communication skills to brainstorm and come up with a solution.
- 5. Active Listening Exercise: Participants will be paired up and given a story to listen to. Afterward, the listener will have to retell the story to ensure they listened actively.
- 6. Group Decision Making Activity: Participants will be given a task or problem to solve, and they will need to make a group decision on the best course of action. The facilitator will lead a discussion on how different communication styles can impact group decision- making processes.
- 7. Feedback Session: At the end of the workshop, the facilitator will ask participants to provide feedback on what they learned and how they plan to use their newfound skills in their daily lives.
